

**NOTICE OF VACANCY
ASSOCIATE JUDGE 23rd JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**

The Supreme Court of the State of Illinois has authorized the Chief Judge of the 23rd Judicial Circuit to post a notice of vacancy for two Associate Judge positions. The new Associate Judge positions are the result of the Supreme Court's appointment of Associate Judge Stephen L. Krentz to the position of Resident Circuit Court Judge for Kendall County and the appointment of Associate Judge Bradley J. Waller to the position of Resident Circuit Judge for DeKalb County.

Applications are now being accepted for these vacancies which will be filled by vote of the Circuit Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit. Applicants must be 1) an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Illinois, 2) a U.S. Citizen, and 3) a resident of the 23rd Judicial Circuit. Applicants must complete two original application forms and submitting both copies to:

Applications must be received in the Administrative Office within 30 days after the date of this notice. The deadline is 5:00 p.m. on September 8, 2014. Applications will not be accepted electronically or via facsimile.

Applicants may be required to make themselves available for an interview with the Circuit Judges of the 23rd Judicial Circuit. Applicants will be notified of the date, time, and place of their interview at the close of the application phase.
